3. CD Music Sales assist with performer cd sales (work in the Elderly Instruments Music Sales Tent).
4. Bike Parking Volunteer "Free Guarded Bicycle Parking" is new to the NFF this year. Volunteers will help check-in and check-out guarded bicycles for festival-goers.
5. Site Coordinator oversee and resolve issues such as seating, crowd control, lost children, and bucket brigade
6. Bucket Brigade this is a fun one! provide the opportunity for festival-goers to support the festival with a donation as you pass through the crowd. Opportunities for organizations, businesses and group of friends available.
7. Children's Area assist children in craft making and games
