The National Folk Festival has five music stages, 25 performing artists and groups/bands, Taste of Traditions Food Court (16 ethnic food vendors plus others), Folk Arts Marketplace (50 traditional crafts exhibitors), Children's Folk Activities Area, traditional games, a parade, storytelling, and cooking demonstrations.

More than 400 volunteers play a major role in making these components come together. There are two and four hour shifts depending on the task. We are asking that volunteers work at least a minimum of four hours during the festival.

Volunteer perks will include a volunteer t-shirt, an invitation to the Volunteer and Performer Party held on Saturday night, a monthly volunteer newsletter and access to the festival "green rooms."
